

DuPont Middle School Student Technology Procedures

By using or taking possession of an Electronic Device owned by Kanawha County School District, a user and their parents/guardians are agreeing with the terms of the Kanawha County Acceptable Use Policy J33A* and the expectations detailed in the Student/Parent Laptop Handbook.

General Precautions:

*iPads must remain in the KCS provided case at all times. The case may NOT be altered in any way.

*iPads must never be left in an unlocked locker, unlocked car or any unsupervised area.

*Students are responsible for keeping their iPad's battery charged for school each day.

Handling, Care, and use of your device:

*Do not allow other users access to an electronic device assigned to you.

*Do not operate the device around food and /or drinks.

*Devices may not be taken into the restrooms.

Security, Storage, and Transporting your Device:

*The Student acknowledges and agrees that the Student's use of the District Property is a privilege and that by the Student's agreement to the terms hereof, the Student acknowledges it is the Student's responsibility to protect and safeguard the District Property and to return the same in good condition.

*Do not throw, slide, drop, and toss, etc. the device at any time.

*The iPad does have identification on it indicating that it is the property of Kanawha County Schools. This identification should not be altered, removed or modified in any way.

*Devices may not be taken into the restrooms.

Content Filtering:

*KCS Acceptable use Policies and WVDE Policy 2460 define content considered inappropriate in a school setting. These guidelines are also observed when the device is outside the school setting.

*All non-education apps must be housed/grouped in the DPMS Restricted Folder

*The user assumes responsibility for not accessing content that is either inappropriate or non-school related whether blocked by a filter at any particular time or not.
